Standing in the big art gallery in London, viewing the massive pieces of art painted by JMW Turner, I wonder how they managed to get a frame big enough for the work and find myself thinking how awesome it would be to have one of my pictures up on the gallery wall with one of these frames. Then I think, 'I haven't got enough space to even think about making something of that size.' But, one day, just like JMW, I might have. The pieces in my exhibition have a theme titled, Relationships. These pictures have been created using anything I can get my hands on to get across this message. I am still learning. It's an exciting journey. I like it when my art makes people think and it gives people something to talk about over coffee and on into the night. Something they don't forget. Like a really good DVD that you really want to buy.
