

## Rooksdown PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

#### Dear residents...

As we hopefully come out of this very wet and depressing time of year you will see more events taking place by the Rooksdown Community Association as notified in this month's Reporter that you will hopefully support. They are to be congratulated on buying a minibus and with this the support they've been able to give to the flooded residents of Buckskin along with the improvements in Rooksdown Youth Project work and over their outreach work in our community.

We now have a full complement of Parish Councillors as we move onto the next stages of the development of Rooksdown and will be setting up working groups to work on specific projects.

News on the big ticket items are as follows:

The Old Hall: Residents near the Hall will have noticed finally the perimeter has been properly secured by Taylor Wimpey to stop all of the antisocial behaviour that has been going on. The results of the planning application for the redevelopment should have been announced by 10th February but as I write this we are still chasing B&DBC for a result. Until this is accepted we cannot proceed to drawing up an agreement on the additional community space. In addition we submitted a Local Infrastructure Fund (LIF) application for funding for the equipment we would need. This is also on hold pending the planning application.

**Traffic Management:** We are pleased to announce that following a meeting today (3rd March) of all the stakeholders a planning application will be submitted this week for the works on The Avenue to be approved. This has to be linked in with the Lodge Junction improvements that Hampshire Highways are working on. We will provide more details at forthcoming RPC meetings.

Pavilions: A planning application has now been submitted for the removal of the pavilions and will be visible on B&DBC by the time you receive this newsletter. Residents who are for or against this are urged to register your views on-line. As soon as we get the application number we will post this on social media sites. The Parish Council previously voted to support the majority view of the residents, following the consultations, for removal. This application is expected to be called into the full Development Control Meeting at B&DBC.

**Listed Barn:** RPC has submitted a Community Right to Bid application on this property in Pumphouse Way. TW Homes had submitted a planning application to remove the listed status and convert to two houses. This has now been withdrawn but we wait to see the outcome of our Right to Bid application.

**Western Triangle Development:** The Homes and Communities Agency (HCA) are still in discussions with a potential developer for this site. Residents may have noticed surveys taking place.

For news on these projects and many others we look forward to seeing you at forth coming Parish Council meetings. Dates can be found on notice boards and on -line and also in this edition of the Reporter.

We have had a number of volunteers who have kindly offered to help distribute the Reporter so thank you. 



Rooksdown Community Association took delivery of a minibus in February.


The bus will be used by community groups to take members on trips far and wide.




RDYC opens Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday evenings for 11-17 year olds.

Rooksdown Parish Council (RPC) is able to offer grants (in the form of money, provision or paying for items, services or facilities) to organisations or individuals for the benefit of some, or all of the residents of Rooksdown. Examples of grants made are: (i) Set up costs for a new Scouts group, (ii) equipment for the community centre, (iii) equipment and facilities for the Youth Club etc.

There are two dates in the year when RPC will award grants.

RPC will receive applications between 1st and 30th April 2014 with awards being decided at the May RPC meeting and also October 1st - 31st being awarded in the November RPC meeting. There is a limit on the total grants which may be made each year. RPC has allocated the sum of £4,000 in the 2013/2014 financial year.






# PROPOSALS FOR THE NORTHERN AREA

The exhibition will go into the specifics of the development in advance of a detailed planning application.




## CALLING ALL DADS




