



### **UPDATE** FROM THE POLICE

Currently 2018 has seen a decrease in the amount of anti-social behaviour in the Rooksdown area compared to last year

There has been throughout the school holidays more reports of youths at the new skate park causing nuisance. With more school holidays fast approaching expect more children to be at the parks and hanging out with friends in the local area

The total crimes reported has gone up in comparison to the previous year

2 thefts from vehicle in the last 30 days – a reminder to secure cars and make sure no valuables are on show before leaving your cars.

2 Burglaries other than a dwelling in the last 30 days

1 residential burglary in the last 30 days – make sure properties are secured before leaving  $\vartheta$  there are other measures that can be used to secure houses e.g. CCTV, sensor lights  $\vartheta$  alarms

Officers are regularly patrolling the area  $\theta$  giving crime prevention advice to those around the area.

# SIATI E PARILE

The SkatePark project was thanks to a successful Local Infrastructure Fund (LIF) bid from the Parish Council which secured funding for the delivery of the scheme and has taken a great deal of effort by all those involved.

The construction of the SkatePark was completed in March, on schedule, and we are very pleased with this new facility. The SkatePark will be a fantastic facility for the community in Rooksdown and will provide a constructive and relatively safe environment where users can develop social and physical skills and where respect of the facility and other users will shine through.

Already the park is being used heavily and it's great to see so many smiling faces from all age groups enjoying the park. Younger users should be supervised closely due to the potential risks.

The last elements were completed in early April including the youth shelter, bins and the area has now been seeded, reducing mud transfer onto the concrete. Hopefully this will also make it a little easier for the users to keep on top of the litter in the area - a lot of the users are making extra effort to keep the area tidy, we'd really like to ask if all users can make sure that they use the bins provided and keep the area as tidy as possible.

In the summer we're organising an opening jam event, which we'll be announcing in the near future, so stay tuned for more information. In the meantime, get out there and enjoy the park!


